If you or an adult member of your household has a serious health condition you may be entitled to significant monthly payments from the Social Security Administration.

Health First has contracted with Social Service Coordinators, Inc. (SSC) to provide information and representation services to qualified Health First members who are interested in filing an application for disability benefits. SSC is available to assist Health First members who have serious physical or mental health conditions apply for Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) benefits through the Social Security Administration (SSA).

If you have a qualifying condition SSC will help you apply for SSDI. If you think you may qualify - or want to find out if you could qualify – please contact us today at **1-866-347-2909**. We are happy to talk with you about your condition and the likelihood that it might result in an approval for SSDI benefits. SSC is prepared to help you through every step of the application and appeals process.

Please call Social Service Coordinators toll free at **1-866-347-2909** any time Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. EST or please complete and return the enclosed postage paid card. Upon its receipt, an SSC representative will call to assist you. Deaf or hearing impaired individuals may call SSC's TTY/TDD number at 1-866-761-5938.

Even if you are not sure if your condition will qualify please call us. We can help you determine whether or not to file an application. We hope to hear from you today!
